

SCAL Fall 2020 Ticketing Procedures (Volleyball)

Visiting Team

- Each visiting team player will have access to buy 2 tickets – recommended for family
 - If a student has a split family, up to 4 tickets will be allowed
- Each visiting paid coach will have access to buy 1 ticket
 - Student managers will be allowed in the contest, but will not have access to tickets for family members to attend.
- On game day, each visiting team will furnish the home team a roster (on that roster will include the visiting scorer and bus driver, along with any split family situations that will require 4 tickets).
- Other than split family situations, both of a student's guests are encouraged to arrive together and should sit together. When buying a ticket to the contest, the patron should indicate which student they are there to support so that can be noted as names on the roster will then be crossed off as tickets are purchased to see that athlete.
- Visiting fans are expected to adhere to the home team's policies on all Covid procedures – social distancing, wearing of masks, etc.

Home Team

- The Home team will have the autonomy to determine how they will distribute the rest of their tickets.

Scouting

- Scouts will not be permitted to enter the gym for volleyball contests.

SCAL Passes

- SCAL passes will not be recognized for entrance into a league contest. SCAL passes will only be granted to school administrators (and will be used by visiting admins for their role in game management).
